European Network of Medical Residents in Public Health

Official Statutes

DEFINITION

Subscribers to these present statutes founded an association governed by the French law of July 1st, 1901 and the French decree of August 16th, 1901. The title of this association is European Network of Medical Residents in Public Health.

The European Network of Medical Residents in Public Health (Euronet MRPH) is a network of national associations of medical residents in Public Health in Europe. It is a non-governmental, independent, and not-for profit international organization.

CONTEXT

The idea of a network emerged in 2008 at the initiative of French and Italian residents, who decided to collaborate in setting up a common protocol for a survey on the satisfaction of residents about the quality of respective residence programs.

This successful experience brought about the idea of extending this kind of collaboration to other projects and countries. Spanish residents joined the group in 2009.

The network was founded on June 30th, 2011 in Paris by the Collège de Liaison des Internes de Santé Publique (CLISP) (France), Consulta degli specializzandi SItI (Italy) and Asociación Española de residentes de medicina preventiva y salud pública (ARES) (Spain).

It was later joined by the Specialty Registrar's Committee (SRC) of the Faculty of Public Health (UK) on November 12th, 2011 in Zaragoza (Spain) and by Portugal on May 5th, 2012.

MISSION

To promote professional excellence among Medical Residents in Public Health in Europe by exchanging scientific knowledge and training opportunities in one hand, and organizing common activities, in the other hand.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- 1- To encourage initiatives by national associations of medical residents in Public Health which share our missions.
- 2- To initiate and collaborate in common projects.
- 3- To enhance professional skills by organizing and coordinating European congresses and meetings for medical residents in Public Health.
- 4- To define and achieve a common core of professional competences in Europe.
- 5- To promote and facilitate foreign internships in Europe for medical residents in Public Health.
- 6- To strengthen the role of public health medical doctors in Europe by communicating on their specific professional competences and working fields to the medical and non-medical communities.

HEAD OFFICE

The permanent address of the head office is: Maison des Associations, 72/74 rue Royale 59800 Lille France

The head office can be relocated by a mere decision of the Executive Committee.

CONDITIONS OF ACCESS AND WITHDRAWAL

To be a member of the network, an organization should be composed of medical residents in public health.

All requirements needed to apply to membership are described in the membership section (article 2) of the procedures and policies document.

All exceptions to these rules should be discussed between the members until a consensus is achieved.

It is possible to have more than one organization from each country. However, only one vote will be taken in consideration for each country in the decision-making processes.

European Network of Medical Residents in Public Health statutes

GOVERNANCE

The network is run by an Executive Committee (EC) and an Executive Desk (ED).

A minimum of four and a maximum of six representatives from each country are appointed to the Executive Committee.

EC members are responsible for proposing and discussing the network's projects and directives.

Detailed composition, tasks and activities of both the ED and EC are defined in the Policies and Procedures document (article 3 -4 -5)

The official denomination "network project" shall be given for projects approved by the sufficient majority of the EC, as defined in article 5 of the Policies and Procedures document, even when not all member countries are partaking the project.

If a member country opts out from a project, it quits claim on the decision process relative to the implementation of the project.

Every project undertaken by the Network will specify which Euronet MRPH countries have agreed with it.

FUNDING

Applications for specific funding could be filled for individual network projects and running costs.

Members cannot be paid for their network related activities, but reasonable expenses for the association can be covered.

UPDATES OR CHANGES OF THE STATUTES

Changes of the statutes should be accepted by all the associations. They need to be approved during one of the network meetings.

LANGUAGE

The official language is English.

DISSOLUTION

The dissolution of the European Network of Medical Residents in Public Health can be decided by at least the two thirds of the countries during an Euronet MRPB meeting.
